AUTHOR GUIDELINES

TYPE & TEXT

- Posters should include a **title, name and affiliation of the presenter(s)** labelled with lettering at least 1" (2.54 cm or 72 point) high from the top of the text area, at top right corner of the poster.
- Text should be **concise enough** to be read from a distance of 4 feet (about 120 cm).
- **Avoid** using all capital letters. You can use italics instead of underlining.
- **Use bulleted lists** where possible instead of paragraphs.
- Recommended **text font style: Arial**
- Minimum recommended text sizes:

Main title - **85 pt font**

Subheadings - **36 pt**

Body text - **24 pt**

Captions - **18 pt**

DESIGN

Recommended Poster Size:

no larger than A0 paper size [841 mm (wd) × 1189 mm (ht)]

& no smaller than A1 paper size [594 mm (wd) × 841 mm (ht)]

Sections and sequence of materials should be **clearly indicated but kept simple**.

The poster should be **self-explanatory**. The **focus should be on major findings** and not on everything you know.

The poster should achieve **coverage and clarity** but also display an **uncluttered and straightforward design**.

ILLUSTRATIONS

Use photos, diagrams, graphs or any other artwork as a focal point to attract attention and these **should be easily visible from a distance**.

Try to make all illustrations (charts, pies, graphs, etc.) into bold graphic display where **text is minimized and symbols are maximized**.

Avoid colours that will distract the viewer from the focal parts of your presentation.

Arrows **clearly indicating the flow of information** from introduction to conclusion are always helpful.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

- All posters should be prepared in advance and brought to the conference by the presenters. The conference organizers will **NOT** be able to receive any posters by mail in advance, print or transport posters.
- On-Site facilities for printing or composing posters **WILL NOT** be provided.
- **No audiovisual equipment** will be provided for poster presentations by organizers.
- **Only one poster** per project/candidate will be allowed.
